In Aichi Prefecture:

- Among the junior high school graduates, 98.5% go to the high school
- Among high school graduates go to university, 58.2% junior college, or vocational school

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(2) Differences between High School and Junior High School

- The major difference between junior and senior high school is that grade promotion or graduation is difficult in senior high school.
- Junior high school is mandatory education, and there is no dropping out. In high schools, bad grades and/or absentee leads to failure of grade promotion or graduation.

Qualifications: at Public High School

Foreign national students who are the residents of Aichi Prefecture with their guardians and have transferred to a Japanese elementary school as fourth grade or above (Must be less than 6 years after entering Japan)

Exam subjects

- An academic test with Hiragana that includes Japanese, Mathematics and English
- Interview

Implementation period (Entrance exam for 2023)

Selective examination for foreigners February 6th (Monday)

Schools providing the Selective examination for foreigners in Nishimikawa

- Koromodai high school (General Course)
- Anjominami high school (General Course)
- Toyota high school technology and engineering (Techinical course)
- Chiryu (Integrated Course)

O Public entrance exam (General Entrance Exam) *Allow to take exams up to 2 schools.

Subject for examinations

- 5 subjects include Japanese, Math, Social studies, Science, English
- Include English listening skills test
- The interview may be implemented depending on the schools.

Exam schedule (Example of entrance exam in fiscal 2023)
Academic skills check tests February 22nd (Wednesday)
* Only take one Academic test even if you choose to take exams for 2 schools.

- Schools run by incorporated educational intuitions
- Distinctive education policy and curriculum
- Admission and tuition fees are higher compared to public schools

③ Evening course in public high school

Study while working

- · 4 hours classes everyday at [day time] or [nigh time]
- More than 3years (possible to graduate in 3 years with hard work)

*There is no evening course high school in Miyoshi city.

Feature 1	 Obtain certifications and/or licenses (Caregiver, Hazardous Materials Officer, Electrician, Chef License)
Feature (2)	 Allows obtaining high school diploma in some schools
